MPS students are involved in over 30 clubs & activities. - Mercyhurst Prep has been a member of the International Baccalaureate Organization since 1985.
- It offers IB diplomas, subject area certificates, and 30 courses in mathematics, sciences, language and literature, modern world languages, history, art, dance, music, and religions of the world.

Mathematics

- The math department offers a wide range of university prep and honors courses, including IB classes in Math Studies, Standard Level, and Higher Level.
- Students annually travel to participate in math competitions and are active in Math Club.

English

- The English curriculum encompasses a wide range of literary genres, literary analysis, public speaking, discussion, collaboration & creation.
- Courses are offered at the university prep, honors, and IB levels.

Information Technology & Business

- With a 1:1 iPad program at Mercyhurst Prep, ninth grade students begin training in digital literacy and the discerning selection of technological tools.

The IT department offers numerous classes in webpage design, presentation software, coding, and the Microsoft Office Suite. - With a full-time technology integration coach on staff, faculty are supported with one-to-one training as needed to ensure digitally literate and accomplished graduates.
- Students also have access to elective courses in banking and credit, financial planning, saving and investing, digital media and marketing and accounting.

- Courses in the engineering design process engage students in project management, innovation and problem solving with access to 3D printers and scanners in a state-of-the-art technology lab.



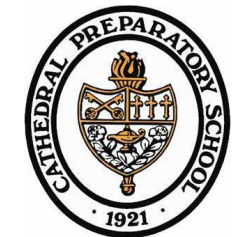

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

It is the goal of AEP to make the application process as quick and easy as possible. From start (submitting the application and necessary documentation) to finish (receiving an I20) should not take more than 2-3 weeks and can be accomplished in under two weeks if all the documentation is completed correctly. What follows is an outline of the process for quick reference.

1. Student submits application with supporting documents. Submission should include:
 - a. The application completed correctly and signed.
 - b. Copy of passport.
 - c. Copy of financials
 - d. Immunization records
 - e. Copy of TOEFL/IELTS (if available)
2. Once application and documentation completed, student should know within 72 hours if accepted.
3. Acceptance letter will be immediately sent and interview scheduled.
4. Upon successful completion of interview, an invoice for a \$3,000 deposit will be sent due immediately. Deposit is refunded minus a \$300 processing fee if student fails to secure a VISA.
5. I20 will be received within 2 weeks (estimated an I20 could take a little longer depending on holidays, mail delivery, or homeland security requests for more information)
6. Student receives I20 and schedules interview with U.S. Embassy.
7. Upon receiving VISA, balance of program fees due to complete enrollment. No spots are guaranteed until fees are paid in full.
8. Student sends AEP flight information to secure airport pick-up.
9. Student arrives and is delivered to home stay or dormitory.
10. Student receives orientation, sets up bank account, receives medical insurance card.
11. Student attends classes.
